



FPSD Safety Protocol

The FPSD safety protocol is subject to change based on the CDC recommendations and guidelines.

PRIOR TO FPSD FACILITY ADMITTANCE

- All players, players, staff, and coaches will be required to complete at home temperature checks prior to arriving to camp/the facility each day. If there is an elevation in your temperature, we require that they stay home
- All players, players, staff, and coaches will be required to complete a 2nd temperature check during check-in by our staff. Any players, players, staff, and coaches that has an elevated temperature will not be allowed to attend training/camp that day
- Visitors will be restricted at all times. No one will be allowed to stay and watch training/camp

DROP OFF/ PICK-UP

- **Drop-off:** Each group will have a staggered designated time slot to arrive in order to minimize traffic. All parents/guardians are asked to remain in their cars during morning drop off and will be given a signal to leave once their player/camper has completed the temperature check and parent has provide information required
- **Pick-Up:** Each group will have a staggered designated time for pick up. Parents/Guardians will remain in the car at all times.
- **FOR CAMP ONLY:** Parents will give their child's name upon pick up and we will guide the child to the car

EQUIPMENT

- All players/players are required to bring their own bag that is closeable and easy to transport by the child, water bottles should be filled, mask if needed, towel, sunblock etc. (Water bottle filling stations will be available but only to be used with staff)
- Sports Equipment and other camp equipment will be rotated throughout the day as well as sanitized after each use and again before the next usage

SANITATION & HYGIENE

- The facility will have standing hand sanitizer units as well as individual hand sanitizer bottles throughout the facility
- Hand sanitizing is required upon entering the building and when leaving
- Daily cleaning, sanitation, and disinfecting all equipment and areas will be completed after each group and at the end of each camp session
- Maintenance personnel will be onsite in order to complete sanitation of high traffic areas and touch points multiple times a day
- Bathroom breaks will scheduled into all group rotations allow for proper sanitation

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Players, players, staff, and coaches will remain in the same pod throughout the entirety of training/camp
- Staff will maintain and encourage social distancing where possible
- **FOR CAMP ONLY:** During activities such as chess, science, and esports, staff will be required to wear masks. players will be encouraged to wear them and social distancing will be enforced

IDENTIFICATION OF POSSIBLE COVID CASE

- In the event that a player/camper or staff experiences any symptoms, they will be self quarantined in the designated room and be required to wear a mask
- Players/players parents/guardians will be contacted and instructed to pick up the camper that is not feeling well as soon as possible
- Staff will be instructed to leave immediately
- The Department of Health and local health will be notified after a positive test has been determined and we will follow all guidelines from our local and state health departments.

FACE COVERINGS

- Staff and counselors will be required to wear face coverings when social distancing of 6 feet between individuals cannot be maintained
- Staff/counselors will not be required to wear face coverings in cases of extreme heat outdoors, during activities with water, and during physical activities
- Face masks will be suggested for all players when social distancing of 6 feet between individuals cannot be maintained. They will not be required to wear face conversing during cases of extreme heat outdoors, during activities with water and during physical activities.
- At all times a face mask must be used when in the building or not playing
